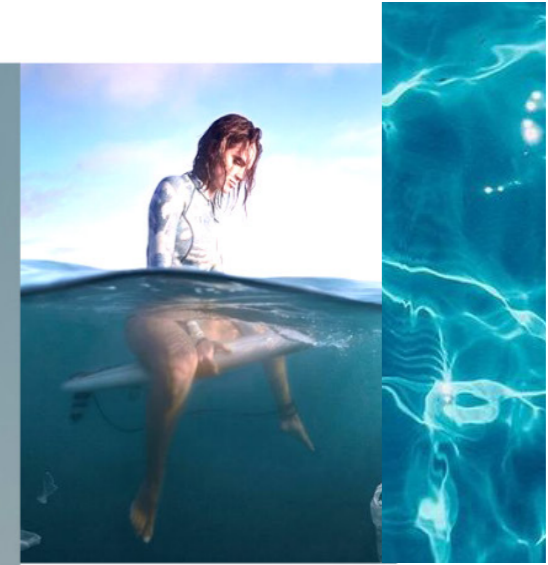
'FLUID FALL'
